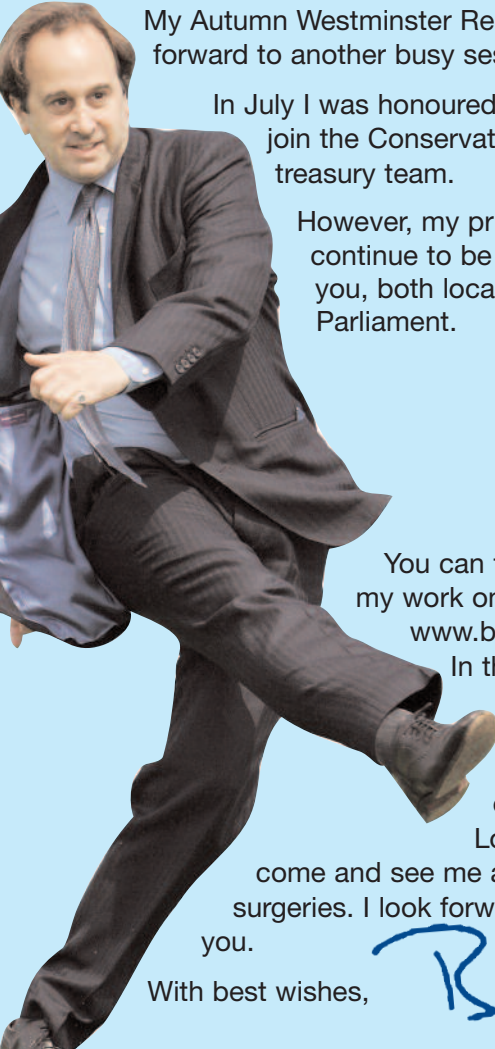


Westminster Report

POWER TO THE PEOPLE!

Despite many promises from the Government, Braintree residents still do not have the community hospital which they need and rightly deserve.

Brooks has challenged the Prime Minister in Parliament and met with him about the lack of progress which has been made. Brooks says "I will continue to press Gordon Brown to honour the promise made to local people and will shortly be presenting a petition to Parliament signed by over 12,000 local people."



THE ROAD AHEAD...

Brooks will shortly be meeting with the new Transport Minister, Tom Harris MP, to press for an announcement of the preferred route for the A120 upgrade.

Brooks says, "Enough is enough. Between congestion and the threat of blight, local people are entitled to both some certainty and some progress from the Government."

Save our Post Offices!



Brooks said, "For many of those who live in rural areas local Post Offices are a lifeline and I want to encourage everyone to join the fight to save our threatened local branches."

Post Office Ltd. has announced plans to close three Post Offices in the Braintree area: in White Notley, Panfield Lane and Bocking Church Street. Local residents have until the 19th of November to register their objections to the planned closures.

"The Post Office is the heart of many small communities and a vital resource for all, particularly the elderly. I will continue to fight vigorously against proposals that are deeply worrying for local people", said Brooks.
